

Program Goals:

The daily program is planned to promote development in all areas of growth: physical, social, emotional, intellectual, and spiritual.

Curriculum:

We use the Baptist WEE Learn Curriculum as a general guide. Each teacher adds other materials for enrichment. There are activities in art, music, science, math, and language arts, as well as social and physical activities. Your child's experiences may include: blocks, sand and water, dramatic play, puppets, cooking and tasting foods, circle time (listening and talking), exploring creative materials.

Learning activities are designed to be relevant to the lives of young children. We encourage personal care, self-confidence, self-control, problem solving, and the acceptance of responsibility to God and others.

Chapel Time:

The children and their teachers join the Director and Pastor in the church sanctuary for a brief (10-15 min.) time, during which songs are sung, a Bible story is read, and a short prayer is offered. The children become aware of our loving God and his son Jesus, and of His love for them as unique and special individuals. We are a Christian program; concepts presented are simple and non-doctrinal.

Minimum Age:

Children must be 2 ½ years old by the first day of attendance. Potty training is not a requirement for this class (except for Extended Preschool (1:30 PM-4:00 PM)). Children in the 3 year olds classes and up must be potty trained.

Class Size:

Staff-Child ratios vary: 1:5 for the 2 1/2 year class (teacher and assistant for 10 students); 1:6 in all other classes (teacher and assistant for 12 students).

Health and Safety:

Each child must have a Virginia physical exam certificate, signed by a physician proving immunization and good health. This certificate must be provided before the first day of school.

Staff on duty has training in First Aid, C.P.R. and Health screening. Regular fire drills are held.

Lunch and Snack:

Parents provide a nutritious lunch and beverage. Afternoon care needs and extra snack and drink. We are a peanut-free school.

Please do not send peanut butter or nut related foods in your child's lunch.**Fees:**

Annual Registration Fee is per child and non-refundable, due at time of registration.

Annual Activity Fee (payable in September) is for in-house educational programs and supplies, as well as tote bags furnished upon initial enrollment. (One bag for total time of preschool attendance)

Tuition: Preschool tuition is paid in 9 monthly payments.

1. Prepaid Tuition (May 2011) is due May 5, 2010.
2. September tuition due at the September 2010 teacher conference.
3. Beginning in October monthly payments are DUE BY THE FIFTH OF EACH MONTH. \$15.00 LATE FEE IS CHARGED FOR TUITION RECEIVED AFTER THE 5TH.

Extended Preschool (1:30 PM-4:00 PM)

POTTY TRAINING IS REQUIRED. Our extended day program is less structured, but does allow for games, puzzles and craft activities. The classes are multi-age. The children have a rest time; they bring their own large towel or small blanket and a small pillow. A separate snack and juice brought from home is refrigerated. Extended care is available for emergencies if there is an opening that day.

Late Pick-up Fee:

A \$1.00 per minute, per family, late fee will be charged for pick-ups later than 1:30 PM (or 4:00 PM for Extended Preschool.)

Application:

Application is made by filling out the Application form and giving it with the registration fee to the Director personally. Registration for the school year 2010-2011 begins February 8, 2010 for families with children currently enrolled in the program. Open registration begins February 22, 2010.

Withdrawal Policy:

If you withdraw your child, please notify the Director 30 days in advance of withdrawal date, in writing. If a child is withdrawn March 1st, or thereafter, the May tuition will not be refunded unless the space is filled by a new student. Changes in days of attendance also require 30 days written notice.
